

Tiny Knitted Bunting by "Touching Little Lives"

YOU WILL NEED

Soft yarn in 3ply with 2.75mm needles or 4ply with 3.25mm needles.

White, cream or pale lemon is perfect.

28" of 4mm ribbon to thread through holes.

2 small buttons.

BUNTING BODY

Cast on 37 stitches.

TIP - slip the first stitch for a neat edge with 'give'.

Row 1 & 2: Knit.

Row 3: K1, *K2tog, YO, Repeat from * to the last 2 stitches, K2.

Row 4: Knit.

Continue in garter stitch throughout.

Work 9 garter stitch ridges after the row of holes.

Next Row (buttonhole): K2, YO, K2tog, Knit to end.

Work 9 more garter stitch ridges.

Next Row (buttonhole): K2, YO, K2tog, Knit to end.

Work 9 more garter stitch ridges.

Repeat Row 3 & 4 once.

HOOD

Cast off 5 stitches at the beginning of the next two rows (27sts).

Work in garter stitch until hood has 17 ridges from the row of holes.

Cast off.

FINISHING

Add a lining if possible.

Fold the hood in half and weave seam together.

Sew buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

Cut the ribbon in half (2 x 14" pieces) and weave through casings.
