I've been working on a simplified crib pattern. If anyone would like to have a go, please feel free. I'm also working on making this even easier and quicker, so please watch this space as they say. Ann Turner. Thank you for the email with the pattern on. I have edited it a little but don't know how to send it back to you, so I'm posting it here, so people can have a go if they want to. When you crochet, if you do fpo and bpo stitches they give lots of different textures. If you alternate the stitches along the row and repeat the row, it gives a rib effect. If you alternate the stitches along the row and alternate the row you get a basket effect. Hope this makes sense, probably not to the knitters though!

People may have to adjust the pattern according to the tension they work at, but hopefully it will give people the idea of how to do the cribs. They really are very quick and easy and as long as it fits the tub, it doesn't matter. Personally I'm a bit of a 'loose' woman.
