

Knitting With Markers

“Sometimes a pattern might ask us count our stitches before a decrease or increase. So for example, your pattern might say, “K18, Inc, K6.” and maybe that shaping is happening in the exact same place for several rows. If that’s the case, K18, then place a marker. You won’t have to count those stitches every time, and the stitch marker will let you know when it’s time to increase.”

Hang them on the working needle at the places stated on pattern (PM).

As you work along every row, move them up with you.

Increase into the stitch before and the stitch after the markers.

Make sure they hang on the side opposite to the working yarn.

Make sure not to knit them with the stitch!
