Any member of Cuddles is welcome to make their own bears, the only thing that matters is that they are small to compliment the size of the baby and thus make the baby seem more normal - also it is difficult for hospitals to source teddies this small.

Over the years the size of the teds has changed and been hospital led.

The most popular size is 3" and I bag these in twos, one for baby and one for parents as a keepsake. Some hospitals (like Medway) have asked for teds for twin losses so I would make three identical teds then.

2.5" teds are called micro teds and 2" teds are known as crib companions.

Obviously you are welcome to use them in any way you wish and I am very happy to make any changes that suit you.
