

Crochet Angels
(American Terminology)
Have fun! Norma x



Large angels are double knit and 4mm hook, small one is 4 ply and 3mm hook

Magic Circle (leaving a 12 inch length of thread for stuffing head with)

1. SC 6 into circle (6)
 2. 2SC into each stitch (12)
 3. SC each stitch (12) }
 4. SC each stitch (12) } or just count 36 SC round amigurumi style
 5. SC each stitch (12) }
- Stuff length of yarn into head
6. SC alternate stitch (6)
 7. 2SC each stitch (12)
 8. SC chain 3 into each stitch finishing with a SC in last stitch (12 x 3 chain loops)
 9. (SC in first chain 3 loop, chain 3, SC in same loop) 12 times. Sl St into first SC to complete row.
 10. 4SC in first chain 3 loop, 4SC in 6th chain 3 loop. This leaves 5 chain 3 loops on each side to form the wings and a circle of 8 SC to form skirt.
 11. SC chain 3 into each of the 8 SC in circle finishing with a SC in the last stitch. (8 x 3 chain loops)
 12. (SC chain 3 SC in same loop) 8 times Sl St into base of first loop to complete row.
 13. (SC chain 3 SC in same loop) 8 times Sl St into base of first loop to complete row.
 14. (SC chain 3 SC in same loop) 8 times Sl St into base of first loop to complete row.
 15. (SC chain 3 SC in same loop) 8 times Sl St into base of first loop to complete row.
 16. Sl St in next 3 chain loop, chain 2, DC in same loop. 4 DC in next 7 3 chain loops, 2 DC in first loop and join top of the beginning 2 chain with a Sl St. Do 2 more Sl St along to neaten edge and bind off
