

Easy lacy knit blanket

The pattern is easy to remember – you'll need a multiple of 11 stitches plus 1

Materials:

For the smallest size, you'll need about 100g of 4ply

2nd size takes about 130g of 4ply

Large size approximately 200g of 4ply.

Please remember that pale colours are best for Cuddles blankets :)

Using a pair of 4.00mm needles, cast on 122[144, 166]

1st row: *k.1, yarn forward k.3 , k2tog, k2tog, k.3, yarn forward.
repeat from * across the row, to the last stitch, k.1

2nd row: Purl

3rd row: Knit

These 3 rows form the pattern, repeat them until the blanket is square, cast off.

Sew in ends of yarn at the start and finish of your work. PLEASE DO NOT IRON or PRESS the blanket.

You could, of course make this bigger, if required. Happy stitc
